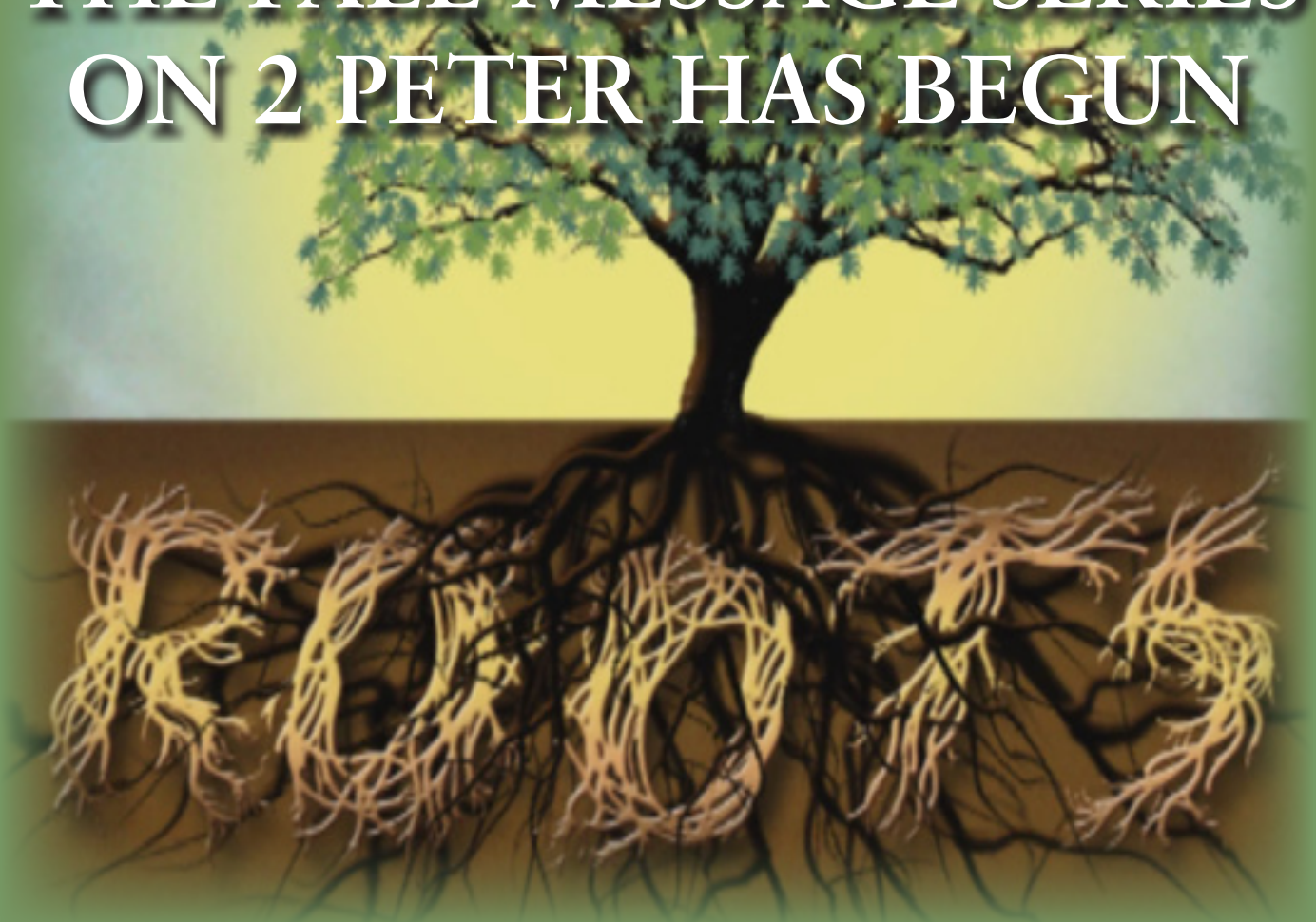

TREND WORK DAY SIGN-UPS

The Trend Work Day has 2 major areas:
HOMES (34 homes – exterior work only)
CLEANUP (work on cleanup projects)

Each home and city project has a project leader that has been recruited and knows what needs to be done to complete their project. There are also foremen with construction experience who are working with the project leaders to make sure that all supplies (such as paint, trim, stucco, etc.) are at the job site and to offer their expertise.

If you are not already a project leader or foreman, you are a participant.

Your job as a participant is to:

- sign up at the canopy in the courtyard over the next 4 weeks
- show up at 7:00 a.m. on October 3rd with a paint brush, deep nap roller with extension, gloves, small bucket, scraper, bag lunch; gloves, hoes, and

rakes (cleanup); and appropriate work clothes (no flip-flops)

- the homes will require some prep work before October 3rd – your project leader will contact you to be a part of the prep work which will be at the end of September

Celebrate Recovery

What is Celebrate Recovery?

Celebrate Recovery is a Christ-centered 12-Step recovery program for men and women based on God's Word and 8 Recovery Principles.

What does it provide?

- An opportunity to work and apply these principles, so we can begin to grow spiritually
- A safe, non-judgmental, environment where hurting people can share struggles, victories, and hope
- A caring atmosphere for fellowship
- A way to celebrate God's healing love

What is the purpose?

The purpose of Celebrate Recovery is to encourage fellowship and to celebrate God's healing power in lives as they work their way along the road to recovery. People then become willing to accept God's grace and forgiveness in solving life's problems.

When is the main session?

The main session meets on Friday nights in The

Gallery from 7:00-8:00 p.m. There is either teaching or a testimony. The last Friday of every month before the main session, there is a Barbecue for \$2 a plate from 6:00-6:30 p.m. After the main meeting, there are gender specific Open Share groups from 8:00-9:00 p.m. and a Newcomer class. After the meeting, we invite you to join us at the Solid Rock Café for fellowship, coffee, and snacks.

What is a Step Study?

The Step Study is a gender-specific group held during the week where the participants are working through the 12-Steps and 8 Recovery Principles.

Childcare is available for \$2 per child.
